The rain also seemed to reduce stink bug numbers a little, but still seeing lots of egg masses so vigilant scouting is a must. Diseases remain at very low levels and Jefferson is the only one to have any Frogeye Leaf Spot. Refer to table below for field specific information.

Arkansas	NK S47K5 Brand	R5	Received 5.25" rain. Plants have started to lean a little from rain and wind last week. Stink bugs running 1/25 sweeps. Disease free. Second irrigation on 7-5 if no rain. Looks very good.
Ashley	NK S47K5 Brand	R5	Received 4.6" rain. Field remains clean of insects and disease. Second irrigation 7-4 if no rain. Looks good.
Clark	Pioneer 47T89R	R1	Received 1.07" rain. Glyphosate application worked very well, however there is another good flush of morning glories. Recommended another 1 qt. shot of glyphosate early next week. Initial irrigation on 7-3 if no rain.
Clay	MorSoy 48X02	R2	Received 2.38" rain. Steady growth, slow to cover middles. Next irrigation scheduled for 7/6/17
Conway	Pioneer 49T31L	R2	Received .55" rain, Irrigated 7/1/17, still seeing good weed control. Should have canopy cover soon.
Crawford	P53T62L	V7	No rain, still seeing excellent growth, applied 32 oz. of Liberty + 1.25 pts. generic metolachlor, Irrigation scheduled for 7/4/17
Crittenden	Bayer HBK 4953	R2	Dryland, Received 2.9" rain. Canopy closure, slight increase in defoliators. Good steady growth.
Cross	Pioneer 47T89		Received 2.1" rain, replanted, starting to emerge, stand counts next week. Looks like we will have and adequate stand
Desha	NK S47K5 Brand	R5	Received 3.8" rain. Field remains very clean of insects and disease. Some leaning from rain and wind. Second irrigation on 7-3 if no rain. Very good looking field.
Jefferson	Stine 42LH22	R5	Received 4.5" rain. Stink bugs running 3/25 sweeps. Frogeye seemed no worse than last week. Very good looking field. Third irrigation on 7-3 if no rain.
Lincoln	NK S47K5 Brand	R5	Received 3" rain. Very clean. Insect and disease free. Another very good looking field. Second irrigation 7-3 if no rain.
Lonoke	Stine 49LD02	V9	Received 2.3" rain. Sprayed with 1 qt. Liberty plus 1.33 pt. Dual Magnum 6-28, now need another rain. Field continues to grow quickly. Initial irrigation 7-6 if no rain.
Miller	Pioneer 41T33R	R5	Dryland field. Field has podded up very well so need good rains to fill them out. Red Banded stink bugs running 2/25 sweeps. Now has 6.04" moisture deficit.
Phillips	USG 74A74RS	R4	Received 7" rain. Very clean with exception of few pigweeds along north edge. Caught 1 stink bug in 100 sweeps.
Prairie	Pioneer 47T36R	R2	Received 1.2" rain. Exhibited very good growth over the past week. Glyphosate application clean it up. Initial irrigation 7-1 if no rain.
Pulaski	Pioneer 46T59R	R2	Received 2.13" rain. Field remains very clean, growing well. Initial irrigation 7-5 if no rain.
Randolph	P53T73SR	V6	Received 2.10" rain. Applied 32oz generic glyphosate + 2.3 pts Prefix. Will evaluate weed control next week.

St. Francis	Asgrow 4632	R1	Received 4.20" rain. Rains have increased drowned out area, continues to have good weed control
Washington	LT4885S	V1	Dryland no rain. Plant stand 97,000, spot planted area that was silted in or flooded ~ 3acres
