Stink bugs made big appearance in southern Arkansas as 4 fields reached treatment threshold this week, with redbanded stink bugs picked up in southern most fields. Diseases remain at very low levels and Jefferson is going to outrun the Frogeye there. Refer to table below for field specific information.

Arkansas	NK S47K5 Brand	R5	Received 2.5” rain. Continues to have a little lean, hoping for no more wind events. Threshold green stink bugs, recommended 4.26 oz. Brigade plus 1% MSO. Disease free. Second irrigation over the weekend if no rain.
Ashley	NK S47K5 Brand	R5	Second irrigation applied 7-11. Threshold redbanded stink bugs with some greens and browns thrown in, recommended 4.26 oz. Brigade plus .5 lb. generic acephate plus 1% MSO. Disease free. Third irrigation 7-19 if no rain.
Clark	Pioneer 47T89R	R2	Received 2.35” rain. Field did not get sprayed due to rain. Very close to lapping. Looking very good. Initial irrigation 7-18 if no rain.
Clay	MorSoy 48X02	R2	Received no rain, ~ 90% canopy, insect pressure remains low, starting to set pods, second irrigation on July 13.
Conway	Pioneer 49T31L	R2	Received .5”rain, very clean, still seeing rapid plant growth, starting to set pods.
Crawford	P53T62L	R1	Received 2.25” of rain. expecting canopy cover next week, insect pressure dropped, initial irrigation scheduled July 17
Crittenden	Bayer HBK 4953	R2	Dryland, received 1.52” rain, has good soil moisture. Excellent vegetative growth.
Cross	Pioneer 47T89	V3	Received 1.8” rain, added small areas of drown out, low weed pressure, initial irrigation scheduled July 22.
Desha	NK S47K5 Brand	R5	Received 1.4” rain. Threshold green and brown stink bugs with few redbanded, recommended 4.26 oz. Brigade plus .5 lb. generic acephate plus 1% MSO. Disease free. Second irrigation over weekend if no rain.
Jefferson	Stine 42LH22	R5	Received .6” rain. Very close to R6. Stink bugs running 6/100 sweeps. Frogeye continues at very low levels. Very good looking field. Third irrigation on 7-18 if no rain.
Lincoln	NK S47K5 Brand	R5	Received .75” rain. Very clean. Insect and disease free. Another very good looking field. Second irrigation over weekend if no rain.
Lonoke	Stine 49LD02	R2	Received .7” rain. Very good growth over the past week. Excellent blooming. Initial irrigation over weekend if no rain.
Miller	Pioneer 41T33R	R5	Dryland field. Threshold redbanded stink bugs, recommended 4.26 oz. Brigade plus .5 lb. generic acephate. Field has very good yield potential if we can catch one more good rain. Running 4.92” moisture deficit.
Phillips	USG 74A74RS	R5	Received 1.1” rain. Second irrigation applied 7-12. Stink bugs running 3/100 sweeps. Disease free. Third irrigation 7-20 if no rain.
Prairie	Pioneer 47T36R	R2	Received 1” rain. Excellent growth over past week. Second irrigation 7-18 if no rain.
Pulaski	Pioneer 46T59R	R3	Received .6” rain. Field remains very clean, growing well. Initial irrigation applied 7-13. Second irrigation 7-21 if no rain.

Randolph	P53T73SR	V10	Received no rain. Insect pressure dropped, defoliation remained low. Excellent growth, expect canopy next week, initial irrigation scheduled for July 16.
St. Francis	Asgrow 4632	R2	Received 2.75" rain. Low insect pressure, applied 32.oz. generic glyphosate plus .33 oz. Classic to control morning glories and grasses 7/11/17.
Washington	LT4885S	V5	Dryland .10", partial herbicide application (mechanical issues), will finish application ASAP. Where applied excellent control. Good plant growth.
