

<b>General</b>	By Chad Norton and Chris Elkins. Rainfall over the past week was very spotty ranging from zero at several locations to 1.5” at Cross 2. As a result, irrigation initiated or resumed for most fields. Insects remain a low levels statewide, although Jefferson is now running 5 stink bugs/25 sweeps. Several of the fields have yet to lap the middles, and as the next generation of corn earworms begin emerging from corn, these fields will be scouted very closely as they should be preferred locations for the moths. Diseases remain non-existent with the exception of Miller where very low incidence of Frogeye Leaf Spot appeared this week. Refer to table below for field specific information.

Ashley	Terral REV 48A26	R5	Received .17” rain. Second irrigation applied 7-3, third 7-10 if no rain. Insect and disease free.
Chicot	Armor 48-D24	R3	Received .45” rain. Second irrigation applied 7-3, third 7-12 if no rain. Very clean.
Clark	Pioneer 54A54X	R2	Initial irrigation should have been applied 7-2. Exceptional flowering and growth over the past week. Very clean.
Clay	MorSoy 4846RXT	R2	Received .75” rain. Excellent growth, should canopy soon. Low insect pressure. Next irrigation scheduled for July 5.
Conway	Pioneer 50A78L	R3	Received no rain. Third irrigation 6-30. Fourth irrigation 7-6. Increase in corn earworms, still below threshold.
Crawford	Pioneer 50A78L	R2	Received .4” rain. Good canopy, insect pressure remains low. Initial Irrigation Scheduled for July 4.
Crittenden	Bayer HBK 4953	R2	Dryland, received 1.25” rainfall, recent rains helped growth, Finally starting to get good canopy. Insect pressure remains low.
Cross - 1	Pioneer 47T89R	R2	Starting second Irrigation. Insect pressure remains low. Good growth.
Cross - 2	Progeny 4930LL	R2	Received 1.5”rain. Excellent growth, low insect and disease pressure. Second irrigation scheduled for 7-7.
Desha - 1	Armor 46-D08	R3	Second irrigation applied 7-3, third 7-10 if no rain. Getting very close to canopy. Remains clean.
Desha - 2	Armor 48-D24	R3	Received .15” rain. Second irrigation should be applied over the weekend. Still growing, close to canopy. Still very clean.
Greene	Delta Grow 4967LL	R1	Received 1” rain. Applied 7-2 29oz Liberty. Good weed control, Initial irrigation July 9.
Jackson	Progeny 4930	V6	Received 1” rainfall, Steady growth. Applied 6-30 32oz Liberty. Scattered plants confirmed Rhizoctonia stem rot.
Jefferson	Stine 41LF32	R5	Fifth irrigation applied 6-29, sixth over the weekend if no rain, could get it close to R6. Stink bugs running 5/25 sweeps. Disease free.
Lincoln	Asgrow AG43X7	R3	Fourth irrigation applied 7-3, fifth 7-11 if no rain. Very clean and continues impressive growth.
Lonoke	Armor 44L21	R2	Third irrigation applied 6-29, fourth early next week if no rain. Very clean.
Miller	Bayer CZ 4540 LL	R3	Dryland field. Good growth over the past week. Very, very low incidence of Frogeye Leaf Spot showing up after last week’s rain. Running 4.94” deficit, need another rain soon.

Randolph	Asgrow 46X6	R2	Received .85" rainfall, Initial irrigation scheduled 7-3. Applied 6-30 32oz generic glyphosate. Auxin damage showing up again in new growth.
St. Francis	Asgrow 46X6	R3	Disease and Insect pressure remains low, continues to have good uniform growth.
Washington	Croplan LC5215	V1	Dryland, received 1" rain. Excellent growth. Pre-emerge continues to hold. Off to a good start on late planted soybeans.
