Arkansas - 1	Asgrow AG46X6	R4	Heligen applied 8-6 and is working very well in controlling corn earworms. Third irrigation applied 8-10. Disease free.
Arkansas - 2	Pioneer P45A29L	R6	Third irrigation applied 8-9. Stink bugs still running 2/25 sweeps, missed their chance to be a problem. One more irrigation should finish it up.
Clay	Morsoy 4846RXT	R5	Received .6" rain. Good pod set, insect pressure remains low, light Frogeye pressure.
Cross	Pioneer 48T22E	R4	No rain. Quickly setting pods, low insect and disease pressure, third irrigation scheduled for 8/11.
Desha	Asgrow AG46X6	R5	Running 1 stink bug/25 sweeps. Closing in on R6. Very good looking field. Disease free.
Drew	Armor 46-D08	R4	Second irrigation applied 8-11. Again, surprisingly insect free.
Faulkner	Delta Grow DG48E10	R4	Received .2" rain. Early R4, Applied 1.28oz. Heligen 8/7. Initial irrigation scheduled for ASAP, current deficit 3.77.
Jackson	Delta Grow DG48E49	R4	No rain. Very uniform field and quickly loading up pods, light insect and disease pressure, third irrigation 8/11.
Jefferson	Pioneer P43A42X	R6	Received .4" rain. Remains free of insects and diseases. Fifth irrigation applied 8-8, one more should finish it off. Excellent looking field.
Lafayette	Asgrow AG46X0	R5	Second irrigation applied 8-10. Remains clean of insects and diseases. Has a chance to be very good.
Lee	Asgrow AG48X9	R5	Received .25" rain. Remains free of insects and diseases. Very good looking field.
Monroe	Asgrow AG46X6	R5	Third irrigation applied 8-7. Remains insect free. Some Frogeye Leaf Spot present, will evaluate again next week. Should outrun it. Good looking field.
Perry	Local Seed LS5386X	R2	Received 1.25" rain. Excellent growth, late R2, 90-95% canopy, Low insect and disease pressure. Finished second irrigation 8/7.
Poinsett	NSGA DrewSoy 5.0	R5	No rain, Quickly filling pods, insect and disease pressure remain low, Third irrigation scheduled for 8/17.
Randolph	Pioneer 47A76L	R4	Received .15" rain. Good pod set, applied 1.28oz. Heligen on 8/7, starting to see the virus work, disease pressure remains low. Finished second irrigation 8/8.
White	Pioneer 47A76L	R5	No rain. Quickly setting pods, poor plant height uniformity, 1.75/25 Corn earworm, disease pressure remains low, Fourth irrigation 8/13.
Woodruff	DynaGro 49L65	R2	No rain. Growth slowed because of drought stress, 3/25 corn earworms, disease pressure remains low. Initial irrigation asap, well is currently down. Deficit currently 3.73.
