

Rice Research Verification Program Update – August 21, 2020

General:	<p>By Ralph Mazzanti: Most all fields are from milk to hard dough stage. Lonoke and Mississippi Counties are draining in line with DD-50. Jackson and Drew are behind couple days and should drain next week. Monroe County, the last planted field, is at 75% heading stage. Rice stink bugs (RSB) remain well below threshold levels.</p>		
County	Cultivar	Stage	Additional Agronomic Details
Drew	RT 7521 FP (Row Rice)	Hard dough	Stink bugs averaging 2 per 10 sweeps. Drain date 8/26.
Jackson	RT XP753 (Row Rice)	Hard dough	Stink bugs averaging 1 per 10 sweeps. One-third straw color on lower end and top end is variable. The field should be ready to drain and flush through next week.
Lawrence	CLL15	Medium dough	Stink Bugs averaging 2 per 10 sweeps. Drain date 8/27.
Lee	Diamond	Medium dough	Stink bugs averaging 2 per 10 sweeps. Drain date 8/27.
Jefferson/ Lincoln	RT 7301 (Row Rice)	Medium dough	Stink bugs running 2-3 per 10 sweeps. Drain date 8/27
Lonoke	RT 7301	Hard dough	Draining 20% harvest moisture 8/30.
Mississippi	RT 7321 FP	Hard dough	Draining 20% grain moisture 8/25.
Monroe	RT XP 753	75% heading	Stink bugs averaging 2 per 10 sweeps.
Woodruff	Diamond	Medium dough	Stink bugs averaging 1 per 10 sweeps. Drain date 8/23.
